Dear Families,

Another busy week of learning here at Fleecefield!

Our Year 5 were amazing last week at their first swimming session, as so many children achieved their Yellow Certificate and are giving their peers confidence in the water!

Also last week, Year 4 had a wonderful visit in the sunshine to Epping Forest, where they braved the heat, took part in orienteering, located historical landmarks using clues and a compass. They also showed their creative skills by taking part in eco-art by using natural materials from the forest to create their own artwork.

I do hope many of you took the opportunity to get vaccinated at the weekend at the Spurs Stadium event. It was reported on the news that there was a very good uptake which will hopefully help us all to keep well.

Last week over a quarter of a million children were off school across the country, remote learning with families who had to look after their children and not go to work. Currently there are 17 schools in Enfield with positive cases and children self isolating. It would seem that cases are rising and there are more schools having to close bubbles as soon as there is a positive case. For this reason we will be continuing to follow the adjustments that we have in place beyond the 19th July. These changes have kept our community very safe and we are one of few schools who have only had to close one bubble over the whole period of pandemic. We will maintain our one way system at home time and wear masks in communal areas, including outside at the end of the day. Thank you again for your support and in helping to keep our school open for all of our children.

If your child or a member of your household displays any COVID 19 symptoms, it is vital that you do a test before returning to school. All tests need to be reported to the NHS whether positive or negative. This is the link to set up your reporting. <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result>
You will need to show us the email notification that the NHS send to you before your child can return to school.

We have been contacted by the council regarding School Streets. This initiative would see Brettenham Road closed to all traffic at specific times for drop off and collection of children to and from school. The council would provide and install all signage to comply with road traffic regulations and the school would be expected to identify appropriate volunteers to operate the scheme morning and afternoon.
