Dear Families,

The children have had another full week of learning, playing and reading together and are demonstrating fantastic behaviour for learning!

This week we started to return to assemblies together in the hall and the children clearly enjoyed the experience and understood why it was so important for us to return to some assemblies in person. Please ask them why we have assemblies.

COVID Update:

We remain vigilant and have kept some measures in place in order to help stop the virus from spreading – most importantly, hand washing & use of hand sanitiser and making sure that windows are open so that ventilation in rooms is good. There is an updated risk assessment on our website for parents who may want to see this.

You will be aware of changes to the guidance regarding close contacts, as a reminder, these are as follows:

- **Schools are no longer responsible for following up positive cases – this is now up to track and trace to let people know they are close contacts**
- **ALL classmates are no longer considered to be close contacts**
- **Children under 18 no longer need to isolate if they are considered a close contact**
- **Children only need to isolate if they have a confirmed positive PCR test**
- **Staff who are fully vaccinated also no longer need to isolate unless they test positive themselves**

Whilst we no longer have the responsibility to inform close contacts, we will try and keep families informed of cases so that you are aware to look out for symptoms in your child. This information will be given via updates on our website page.

With so many children being back at school, we must be aware that cases may begin to rise so we are constantly monitoring the situation and are prepared to step up restrictions if necessary.

Please look out for the invitation to meet your child’s new team and to find out about the learning they will be doing this term. Staff will also be sharing organizational information with you and there will be an opportunity to ask questions too.

Thank you to all those Year 5 and 6 parents who joined me for the Secondary Transfer meeting, I hope you found it useful. Please remember to take the opportunity to visit as many of the schools
