Dear Families,

As part of our work on Online Safety this week all of our children had an interactive and fun session with two leading internet safety experts. Heather and Tina worked with the children to help them to recognize how they can keep themselves safe and recognize risks. The children were brilliant at explaining what they should do to keep safe but when presented with scenarios, many struggled to make good choices. As parents we would never allow our children to cross a busy road without giving them the skills and knowledge to recognize how they can keep themselves safe and recognize risks. Using the internet can be brilliant and also dangerous unless we support our children and help them to keep safe and recognize risks. One of the biggest concerns is WHO are our children talking with and if they know where our children are. Our parent survey has been sent to you so that we can establish what more we can do to help **you** with keeping our children safe. Please send your response to us as soon as possible.

We are also sending the link below which is a presentation for parents. The session lasts for 60 minutes and is full of practical and essential advice for you to use at home.
