Dear Families,

I am very pleased to report to you that this week, our approach to starting the after school clubs for year groups has been very successful. The children have had a great time, getting fitter, developing their PE skills and being with their friends. We are planning to extend this provision slowly over the term as long as we can ensure everyone remains COVID safe!

I am also delighted to let you know that our attendance figures continue to be good, with more than half of the school exceeding our target! As ever, we appreciate all of your efforts to make sure that your children are in school every day and on time – thank you.

Well done to Green and Purple Classes with an amazing 98.08%!

Last week I wrote to you about the concerns we are sharing about keeping safe around the entrances of the school. Despite this, we have still seen parents stopping on the school driveway by the gates, stopping on zig-zag and yellow lines and blocking the way to families with buggies and toddlers. We have welcomed the attendance of Traffic Enforcement Officers at our gates and have requested that the CCTV car also monitors. I have included the information below from the London Borough of Enfield website and a better link for you to report your concerns. There are no excuses for putting someone in danger, it takes seconds to injure a child!

Parking restrictions

You can report a vehicle if it is violating any parking restrictions. A vehicle is parked illegally if it is:

- double parked (more than 50cm from the kerb)
- on school entrance markings
- on the pavement or verge (except in a legal pavement parking space)
- on waiting restriction lines (yellow lines)
- parked on or next to a dropped kerb

If you do not follow parking restrictions, you may receive a **Penalty Charge Notice** and your vehicle may be removed.
